EVANSTON, III. (Jan. 25, 2018) — With 22 confirmed cases in 2017 to date, and just one case in 2018, the world is on the brink of eradicating polio, a vaccine-preventable disease that once paralyzed hundreds of thousands of children each year.

Rotary gives \$53.5 million to help eradicate polio and challenges the world to continue the fight to end the disease.

Rotary is giving \$53.5 million in grants to support immunization and surveillance activities led by the Global Polio Eradication

Initiative (GPEI).

More than half of the funds will support efforts to end polio in two of the three countries where polio remains endemic:

• Afghanistan: \$12.03 million • Pakistan: \$19.31 million


Further funding will support efforts to keep 10 vulnerable countries polio-free:

 Central African Republic: \$428,000
- Chad: \$2.33 million
 The Democratic Republic of Congo: \$6.48 million

- Somalia: \$3.29 million
 South Sudan: \$835,300
 Syria: \$428,000



16 Million Volunteer Hour each Year




